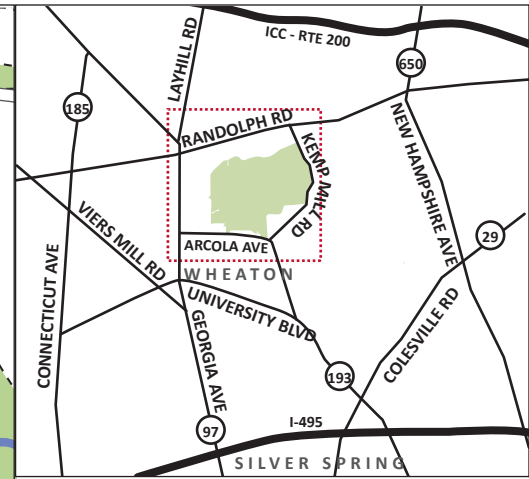




# WHEATON REGIONAL PARK TRAILS

Wheaton Regional Park, Montgomery County's first regional park, offers both natural surface and hard surface trails. The 4-mile hard-surface trail system is located in the southwest portion of the park. The natural surface trail network includes bride trails (the park features an equestrian center) and nature trails oriented to Brookside Nature Center.
